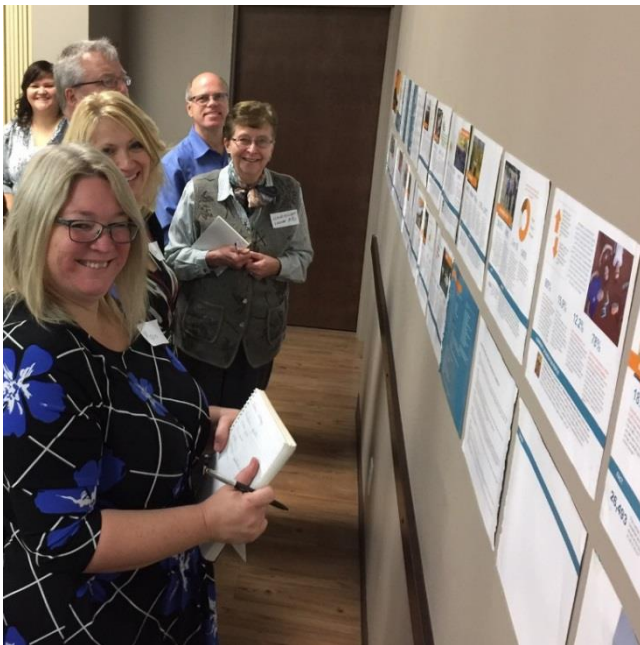


Vital Signs Report: Mind the gap – together

We all feel we know our community really well. But do we? Since November 2016, the Selkirk and District Community Foundation has come to know our region better than ever.



In April, we will be releasing the results of our community consultation and research in a report we call *Vital Signs: Mind the Gap*. This report will be a 24-page community check-up that looks at nine key indicators. These subject areas were chosen by local residents and leaders and include inclusivity, housing, health, the income gap, environment, safety, older adults and learning - kids and youth as well as arts, culture, recreation and tourism.

This report will help benchmark where we are and where we need to go to make this an even better community in the next decade.
