## Books for 1000+ Babies

When Cynthia Webster started teaching elementary school she could tell immediately the children who had books read to them. "I taught Grade 1 and in the first week I could tell which child had been read to - their comprehension of language was obvious," says Cynthia who taught for 17 years in Winnipeg and is now retired in Gimli.

Born in 1940, Cynthia's mother, also a teacher, use to read adult books to her because there simply weren't any children's books on the market. When her mom passed away, Cynthia started the *Amma's*

*Bookshelf Fund* at the SDCF in her memory.

Every year the fund helps buy hundreds of copies of *Good Night Moon* and puts them in the hands of every parent who takes a newborn home from the Selkirk & District General Hospital. Inside the jacket is a small note that says; "This is my first book. Please read it to me." By now Cynthia estimates over 1,000 babies have their first book thanks to Amma and others who believe in the magic of books.

## Taking water protection to US teachers

A SDCF grant for a Lake Friendly project will be used to help leverage another grant from a North Dakota foundation to help spread the word about how we all need to protect our water resources on both sides of the border.

Colleen Sklar, Executive Director at Lake Friendly, used a SDCF grant last year to help create the H2O IQ teachers' guide for Manitoba schools.

"The H2O IQ resource is designed to provided educators with user-friendly information, tool and resources to explore issues related to water and the Lake Winnipeg watershed,



that stretches from Banff to the Great Lakes to the United States," Sklar says.

Now in its second 500-run printing in Manitoba, Colleen is focused south where she believes teachers in North Dakota

would like access to the guide as well

"We now want to use this model and apply to US Foundations to get it translated for US schools, get enough printed for all the schools in the Grand Forks-Fargo region," she says.

He has \$3,400 in reserve at the SDCF fund and when it reaches \$10,000 he'll be able to officially open up his own fund. The interest on the fund will be used to give grants to community groups.

"I put my trust in the board members of the foundation to decide where the grants need to go," Jeremy says.
