

# Celebrating 20 years of being *Here for Good*



### **Greetings from the Chair**

In 1995 some visionary leaders decided that together we should plan for the future health and welfare of our community.

Inspired by an offer from the Thomas Sill Foundation to seed a local foundation, our predecessors found matching donations in the community and launched the Selkirk and District Community Foundation, 20 years ago.

The concept was brilliant and simple. Donations collected under the SDCF banner would be carefully invested and only the interest off the donations would be given to charitable organizations doing good work in the City of Selkirk and the Rural Municipalities of St. Clements and St. Andrews. Under this concept all your donations are invested and never spent, rather they work as a resource forever.

Fast forward 20 years and we have lots of good news to share.

One of our first donations was \$40 and since then hundreds of donors have grown the SDCF assets to \$8.4 million. From the interest earned we've gone from funding five

organizations in 1998 to 32 organizations in 2015. In 20 years, more than \$1.4 million has gone back into the community for needs as diverse as childcare and senior centres; hockey rinks and heritage sites; shelter for women, children and the homeless; scholarships and bursaries for our future leaders; and projects as worthy as cleaning up Lake Winnipeg.

As we celebrate the SDCF's 20th birthday in the pages of this annual report we hope you'll see how everything is adding up nicely. Thanks to you, we're Here for Good.





When Dr. Ike Hussain died in 2012 Selkirk resident Jean Oliver was quick to donate to the SDCF in his memory. For her and so many in the community Dr. Hussain represented the drive and determination that helped create our foundation. Jean remembers how for two years in the mid 1990s Dr. Hussain and Selkirk Hospital CEO Elmer Kuber hosted 20 people in the hospital boardroom as they planned for a future foundation. The monthly meetings would have to be at 7 a.m. so Dr. Hussain could shepherd the project before heading into surgery. "He was determined we would see this come to fruition. He was a founder and early major donor. The rest of us just followed him," says Jean, the first vice-chair of the SDCF board of directors. When the Selkirk Hospital was to become integrated into the Regional Health Authority, Dr. Hussain wanted the bequest and donation monies of the hospital to remain in our community and thought a community foundation was the best place for them. These were some of the very first funds at the SDCF and exceeded \$520,000 by 1998.

### **Inspiring young donors**






Katherine Clegg (left) and Kit Muir made their first donations this year.

## More donations naturally lead to more grants

We created our first fund in 1995. By 1997 we had enough interest collected that we could start sharing grants and we haven't stopped since. The international recession slowed our income for a few years, but it didn't stop our ability to provide grants every year.





### **Getting kids out doors more**

A grant to the Selkirk Friendship Day Care Centre last fall makes sure kids get outside to play regularly. When the centre's daycare adopted the "Leave No Child Inside" program it needed help with new outdoor play equipment. The foundation contributed \$7,000 to the project so it can start to create a new playground site for the preschoolers this year.

### First homeless shelter opens

After 12 years of volunteering at Our Daily Bread Soup Kitchen, Rene Gauthier knew what he needed to do next. After watching people arrive week after week at the soup kitchen door in Selkirk, cold with having spent the night outside in freezing temperatures or dehydrated by the summer heat, he realized our area needed a homeless shelter. Christened St. Francis Place, the shelter opened in Selkirk in the winter of 2014 and had over 100 visits in March 2015 alone.

### New gym breaths new life

While the staff and 105 kids at Walter Whyte School in Grand Marais were pretty excited to get the flooring of their 1960s school gym replaced, there was one problem. When the job was over there was no money left over to put in new inserts in the floor for volleyball and badminton poles or to buy new nets. Fortunately the Western Canada Summer Games Legacy Fund at the SDCF was created for projects just like that. The fund was used to issue a grant of \$1,200 to help finish off the renovations.



## Reserves create long term fund

The Selkirk Youth Hockey Association has hosted several major hockey events in Selkirk - very successfully. In fact in many cases the events from World Juniors to World Women's hockey left some extra money in the bank, which the association has used to help local kids get in, and stay in, hockey. To seal its commitment to opportunities for kids in Selkirk and the region, the SYHA created two new funds this year - Selkirk Youth Hockey Association Fund and the Selkirk Youth Hockey Association Education Fund at the SDCF. "We want to ensure that as many kids as possible have the opportunity to practice and play hockey and make sure the programs are affordable and accessible in the future, too," says SYHA treasurer John Buffie.

### Aunt creates unique fund

In 2001 when Edith Schofield of Selkirk passed away, her will revealed a very unique idea. She had created a trust fund to take care of the needs her niece Erma Hill might have. Aunt Edith planned a step further and also instructed that upon Erma's death any monies left in the trust should be turned into a fund at the SDCF. She designated that the interest off those funds be used to support St. Amant Centre in perpetuity. Erma Hill, 63, passed away last year and a fund in her name valued at over \$885,000 has been created at the SDCF.

### Young dad remembered

After Curtis Niemi had a heart attack and drowned while taking his daughter swimming in June 2012, his family and friends rallied to make sure his memory would never be forgotten. For the last three years they've been hosting fundraisers to remember Curtis. With some of the early donations they've seeded a start up fund at the SDCF. When the fund reaches \$10,000 it will be officially launched as the Curtis Niemi Legacy Fund and will disperse grants to some of Curtis' favourite passions – hockey, soccer, literacy, health and children.
